Introduction:

Centre for Disabled Children Assistance (CDCA) is a non-for-profit making specifically children with disabilities (CwDs) focused non-governmental, non-partisan and secular non-governmental organization. CDCA is founded by a group of nine people with the aim of advancing the lives of CwDs those from the remotest part of the Himalayan region of Nepal. It is officially registered with District Administration Office (DAO) of Kathmandu in 2006 with the registration number-861. And, has an affiliation with Social Welfare Council (SWC) of Nepal since November 5, 2011 (affiliation number-20,726).

CDCA works in following areas:

- CDCA Care Home.
- Education/ Scholarship.
- Wheelchair repair & maintenance program.
- Wheelchair distribution.
- Income Generation & Women Empowerment.
- Medical Support.
- Awareness, prevention campaigns.

1. CDCA Care Home:

“CDCA Care Home” where children with physical disabilities located in Budhanilkantha Municipality wards no -11, Kapan, Kathmandu, Nepal. We have 10 children including 6 boys and 4 girls. Along with that 23 children are getting scholarships for education. All children are from the remote areas of Hilly and Mountainous regions: Solukhumbu, Gorkha, Jumla, Kavre, Sindhupalchowk, Rasuwa, Khotang, Okhaldhunga, Dolkha and Kapilastu. These children belongs from family facing economic hardship. CDCA Care Home provide lodging, fooding, medical treatment, education in free of cost. Children are facilitated by children e-library, study room.

From this Nepali New Year Ang Dawa, Maila, Manisha, and Mithun are going to leave CDCA as their replacement we are going to add new children from the new academic calendar. Ang Dawa & Manisha had already left CDCA. Manisha returned to her family and Ang Dawa had gone to Pokhara.

2. Education

Because of COVID -19 outbreaks, the ministry of education has changed the academic calendar & this year Pradip Gurung & Ramchandra Bohra is going to give the SEE (Secondary Education Examination). From the 5th of January to 13th of January, there was a second terminal exam of children & now their 3rd term exam is running.

Like Mithun, Rupak & Aita Ram, this year Nima Lhamu, Ang Dawa, Manisha, and Maila have graduated high school. Ang Dawa Sherpa and Maila Ghale graduated high school on Computer Science. As Manisha Magar & Nima Lhamu Sherpa graduated high school on Education.

Whereas, Yangchen Lhamu and Furi Sherpa has joined high school. Yangchen Lhamu is studying Education whereas Furi Sherpa is studying Humanities. Similarly, Rachana Rai will join the high school in the new session in June.

Ang Dawa Sherpa is in Pokhara. He has got a job in Pokhara, will continue his further study there. Manisha Magar is living with her family, wants to support her family. Maila Ghale is working in CDCA. He wants to continue his study in BCA (Bachelor in Computer Application), has got 50% a scholarship but studying BCA is expensive & his family can't pay 50% as well. So he is planning to join BBS (Bachelor in Business Studies).

3. Wheelchair repair & maintenance project:

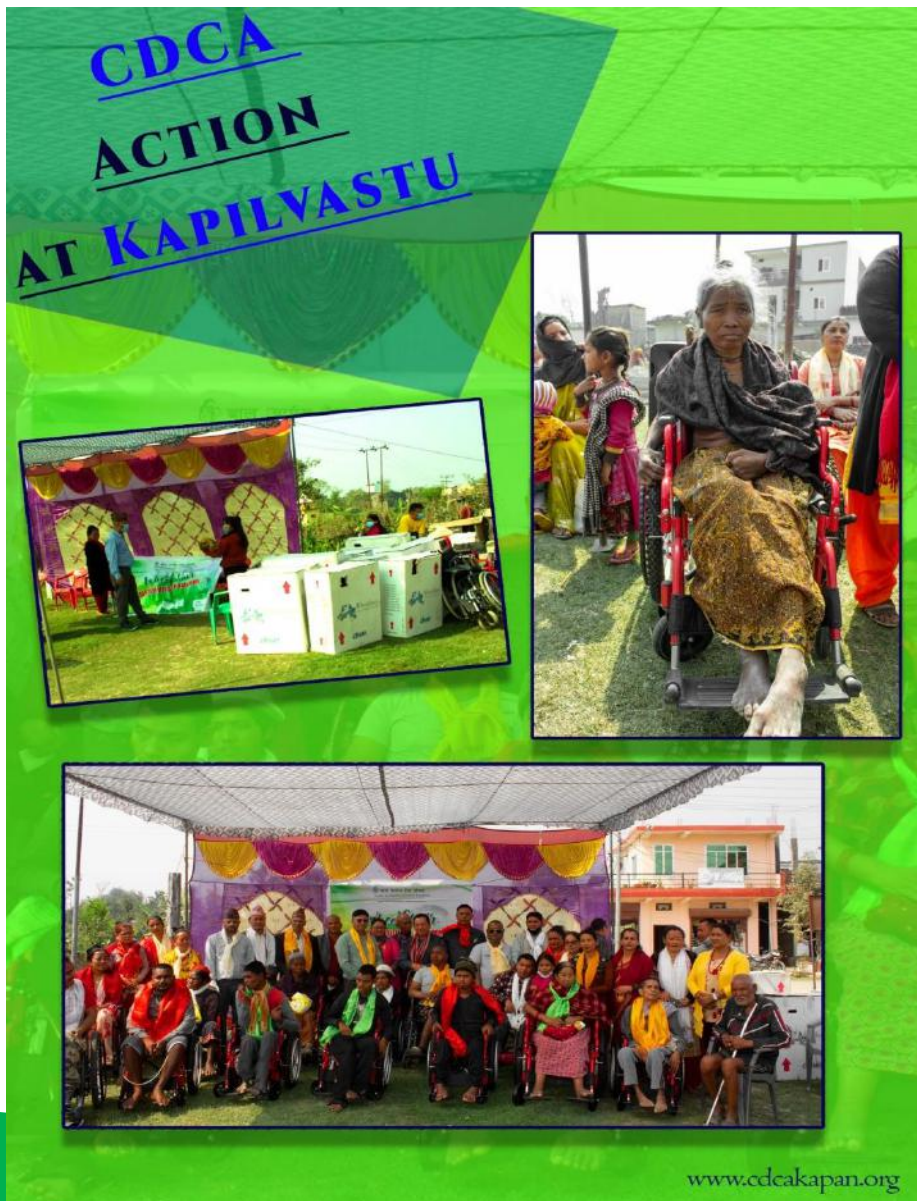
Currently, we don't have much work in a wheelchair repair program. We are attempting to collect the wheelchairs which need repair & maintenance. We are distributing wheelchairs that have been donated by Wheelchair Foundation along with that we are also collecting old wheelchairs which can be repair. We are appealing to individuals and organizations to provide us their wheelchair that can't be used.



Wheelchair Repair Program



Previously we have distributed wheelchairs in State no. 1 & 3. After that, there was a request from the Ishapur Municipality, Sarlahi district, State no.2 for the wheelchairs & 23 wheelchairs have been distributed there. Later on, there was also a request for a wheelchair from Buddhabhumi Municipality, Kapilvastu district State no.5 & 20 wheelchairs have been distributed there. Collaboration with the municipality we have distributed these wheelchairs because while distributing wheelchairs in the State no.1 & 3 all the traveling & accommodation was bear by CDCA & which was wasteful expenses. So we requested the municipality for the traveling & accommodation cost at least.

Wheelchairs that have been donated by the wheelchair foundation are almost completely distributed in different parts of Nepal. Our further plan is to get the wheelchairs along with that follow-up these distributed wheelchairs and provide them services if they need them. Comparing to



other countries Nepal's geography is not good so wheelchairs need follow-up and monitoring & provide services to those devices which is our main project goal or objectives.

By the time of wheelchair distribution, we also found out that there is more number of disabilities in the Terai region of Nepal compared to the Hill & Himalayan region. There is also no proper care for disabilities from their parents as well & they are treated like an animal that made downhearted for us.

4. Tailoring Training:



CDCA has been conducting a Tailoring project since 2011 in Kapilvastu Shivaraj Municipality as a part of the skill-oriented program for the upliftment of the status of the women with the support of SAMSAL.

CDCA was unable to monitor the tailoring project and farewell our old trainee & unable to welcome newcomers trainees in 2020 due to COVID. We have been to Shivaraj Municipality, Kapilvastu for the tailoring project monitoring (welcoming new trainees and farewell of old trainees) & along with that, we had taken 3 wheelchairs 1 kanga wheelchair for Darshan Adhikari & 2 manual wheelchairs for Ram Kumar Tharu & Aakriti Gautam on 1st Jan 2021.

On 2nd January we met with Chanda Thapa trainer of the Tailoring Training Project and trainees of 2019 & 2020 as well. On that day we welcomed new trainees and farewell old trainees. All the trainees were students who had just completed secondary education and studying in higher secondary education. We asked old trainees about the project & they said they were satisfied with the training they got. With this training now they are able to work in tailoring which helps in their economic upliftment before that just they were helping their parents in farming but now if they got financial support they can run tailoring business with their own skill & experiences.

We asked new trainees about these projects and they requested to increase training periods because they don't get enough training because of the COVID-19. Generally, the training starts in mid-April and ends on 31st March but this year we had decided to end this project on 15th of May according to trainees request and starts a new session from the same date as well.

According to trainer Chanda Thapa they are now learning they have a completely baby item and start learning item of girls. According to her, they had completed 9 items:

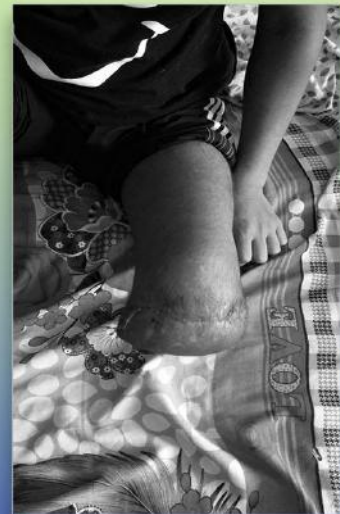
